

Applying for Financial Aid (FAFSA Options)

Starting January 1, 2012

1. **Apply Online** (recommended)
 - a. Need to register for a Pin number www.pin.ed.gov
 - b. Both parent and student need to apply for their own pin.
 - c. FAFSA on the web www.fafsa.gov
 - d. Need the 2012-13 version, available January 1, 2012

OR,

2. **Download a PDF FAFSA**
 - a. Go to www.federalstudentaid.ed.gov
 - b. Go to “For students, Parents, Counselors”
 - c. Go to “APPLY”, then “Other FAFSA Filing Options”
 - d. Need to select 2012-13 Version

OR,

3. **Call for a paper FAFSA to be mailed to you.**
 - a. Call Federal Student Aid Information Center 1-800-4-Fed-Aid (1-800-433-3243)
 - b. Need 2012-13 Version
