

RG Drage Cafeteria Meal Charging Policy 2025-2026



RG Drage will be participating in Community Eligibility Provision for the 2025-2026 school year. This means that every student can receive one (1) breakfast and one (1) lunch free of charge every school day. Additionally, if a student wishes, he/she may purchase extra a la carte items or an additional lunch for a price. If a student does not have money in his/her account, the student may go up to \$6.50 in the negative. Once a student has reached \$6.50, no further charges will be allowed.

Students are reminded daily of what the account balance is. When students have reached the maximum charging amount, a phone call may be made and/or a letter may be sent home to notify the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) that a negative balance has occurred and what the payment is.

All attempts should be made to pay the negative balance in a timely manner.

*If a student is a senior, and there is a negative balance on the lunch account at the time of Awards Day, the student will not receive his/her portfolio inserts on Awards Day until it is paid off.

Seniors, please note: Any positive account balance at the end of the school year can be reimbursed upon request. Any account carrying a positive balance of \$4.99 or less will not be reimbursed unless specifically requested by a parent/guardian.

*If a student is a junior, and there is a negative balance on the lunch account, the balance will carry over to the next school year. This will not re-set; the maximum allowance is \$6.50.
